Literacy

This half term we are reading the story of Nibbles the Book Monster. Whilst using this book as a stimulus, the children will be refining their sentence writing skills, using full stops and capital letters, and using 'and' to join words and sentences. We will also learn about plural words and the rule for adding 's' or 'es'. Year 2 children will also be looking at adverbs and what happens to words when we add 'ly'.

Mathematics

Year 2 children will begin the term using money. They will be able to recognise the coins as well as being able to problem solve and reason about money. They will then move onto multiplication and division, focusing on 2's, 5's and 10's. Year 1 children will begin the term looking at geometry. They will be looking at 2D and 3D shapes and their properties. They will also be doing more work on place value, addition and subtraction and measures.

Computing

This half term we will be brushing up on our basic computer skills. We will think about what is technology and what do we have in our environment. Then we will be able to log on to the computers, open a programme, use a mouse to navigate the cursor and then log off and shut down.

RE

We will be focusing on stories of love and forgiveness, starting with the story of the Prodigal Son. The children will use this to link to their own experiences. We will also look at the story of the unforgiving Servant and what Jesus was trying to teach us through this story.

PHSE

This subject will also link closely to D&T and Science as we look at keeping healthy. The children will be looking at what ways they can stay healthy, how they can look after themselves, especially personal hygiene and hand washing.

Trips and Visits

We are lucky to be having another sports coach in to school for Key Stage 1 this term. We will be doing multi-skills on a Wednesday afternoon with the coach.
