Literacy

We are looking at a fiction text this half term, 'The Curious Case of the Missing Mammoth' by Ellie Hattie. The children will explore the text and work up to writing their own version.

There will also be many links to history this half term. We will be listing differences between castles, finding out and writing about William the Conqueror, learning about his army and why he came to England.

Mathematics

In Year Two we will be continuing our work on fractions and continuing to consolidate the four operations of number. We will be doing a lot of work on measures including weight, length and capacity. The children will also get the opportunity to improve their time work. We will also focus on reading the time to 5 minute intervals.

In Year One, we will be revisiting arithmetic and looking at multiplication and division. We will also look at measuring weight and volume. We will also be talking about position, direction and time.

Computing

This half term we will continue to use Paint on the computers. The children will look at different artists and use the tracker pads and mouse skills to replicate their works. They will continue to use the skills of logging on to a computer, saving their work in a designated folder and shutting down a computer correctly.

RE

We will be looking at what a symbol is and what symbols Christians use. We will also look at the meaning of these symbols to Christians.

PHSE

This half term will focus on feelings – feeling loved, feeling proud, feeling jealous and feeling lonely and how we can deal with these feelings. We will also look at how these feelings link to behaviour.

The year 2 children will be going on their residential trip to Tattenhall.
