### Flu Vaccinations

The NHS immunisation team will be visiting school on Tuesday 28th November to deliver the childhood flu programme.

The Nasal Flu Vaccine has proven to be highly effective in reducing the number of respiratory related GP and hospital visits in school aged children and is offered to all pupils from Reception - Year 6.

This is a paperless exercise again this year and you will receive details of how to complete a consent form via the NHS website today. You should complete one for each child.

Consent forms must be submitted at least 2 days before the session to be triaged by a nurse.

Just to let you know that the school shop will be open on Wednesday 22nd November. If your child wishes to bring in some money then they do not need more than £2. The School shop will only be open for Year 1 to Year 6 on this occasion.
